# International Service-Learning Trip to Bigwa School, Morogoro, Tanzania:


This trip is under the auspices of the African Sisters Education Collaborative, in cooperation with the three-member higher education group: Marywood University, Chestnut Hill College, and Rosemont College. All the students will be taking a three credit history course, Special Topics: Tanzania Background, in order to participate in this service trip. The class will be lead by the professors chaperoning the trip and will be held via webcam, so that students from each of the schools will be in the same class. The class will cover the language, culture, and history of Tanzania. The University students will be coaching the Sisters and the girls at Bigwa in English writing. The students at Bigwa are instructed and tested in English. However, their understanding of the written language is insufficient, making it very difficult for the students to pass their exams and continue their education. Through the three-credit course the University students will learn strategies to teach the Bigwa students the basics of good English writing.

The University students will also be working in an orphanage during the eleven–day trip. Disease has left many of Tanzania's children parentless and there is plenty of work involved in taking care of children who populate the orphanages.

Through this service experience, University students will also learn more about the culture and customs of the people of Tanzania.







### The run will benefit two of Marywood's International service trips: San Lucas, Guatemala, and Bigwa School, Morogoro, Tanzania. Both of these trips take place in May 2012.

#### International Service Trip San Lucas, Guatemala:

Students from Marywood have traveled to Guatemala to work with the San Lucas Mission in Guatemala for the past several years. The San Lucas Mission was originally founded by the Franciscan order in the late 16th century, with the building of the church around 1584. Guatemala has a well-known mission of long-term devotion to the enhancement and enrichment of the whole person-spiritually, intellectually, and physically-by addressing both the immediate effects of poverty and its underlying causes.

Efforts at the San Lucas Parish attempt to respond to the expressed felt need of the people, working to build the infrastructure necessary so that the people might grow out

of the process of poverty. As a volunteer at the San Lucas parish, students will learn about the efforts in San Lucas and participate in the cross-cultural experience the parish offers. Groups will spend most of their time working at sites, learning, understanding, and appreciating the local culture. Through working alongside Guatemalans, receiving talks from community members, and observing the goings-on of the area, group members will learn about the richness of the Maya culture, the work of the parish, and the life of Guatemala.

Some of the works students may participate in include: gardening in the coffee nursery, picking coffee, helping build community structures (such as the women's resource center), helping construct temporary housing. Additionally Marywood students will travel to Chichicastenango and work in a Christian school giving children English lessons.
